# Protecting our Home

The beginning of a new year is a wonderful time to consider how we live in relationship to the beautiful creation God has placed us in and asked us to care for.

Might we begin by thinking of ways to simplify our lives to be more in harmony with our world?

Let's consider plastic:

- At the beginning of last year, the organization Only One predicted: "In 2021, a staggering 14 million metric tons of plastic waste will make its way into the world's oceans." For reference, that's more than half the weight of the entire U.S. adult population.
- Less than 10% of plastics produced are recycled. Of that number, only 2% is effectively recycled (recycled into a product of equal or higher value)
- Every minute, another garbage truck's worth of plastic enters the ocean

Question for prayerful consideration: How can I reduce the amount of plastic I use? What can I use instead of plastic?
